Section 1: Product Identification

- **Product Name:** Carvacrol
- **Chemical Formula:** C₁₀H₁₄O
- **CAS No:** 499-75-2
- **Synonyms:** 5-Isopropyl-2-methylphenol; Isothymol
- **Recommended Use:** Used in flavorings, fragrances, antimicrobial formulations, and chemical intermediates.

Section 3: Composition / Information on Ingredients

- **Concentration:** $\geq 95\%$

Section 4: First Aid Measures

- **Inhalation:** Move to fresh air. If symptoms occur, seek medical attention.
- **Skin Contact:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.

- **Ingestion:** Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting. Seek immediate medical attention.

- **Suitable Extinguishing Media:** Water spray, foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide (CO₂).
- **Specific Hazards:** Combustion may produce carbon oxides.
