Section 1: Product Identification

- **Product Name:** Cyclohexanol
- **Chemical Formula:** C₆H₁₂O
- **CAS No:** 108-93-0
- **Synonyms:** endo-Cyclohexanol; Isoborneol
- **Recommended Use:** Used as solvent, intermediate in chemical synthesis, plasticizers, and in industrial applications.

Section 2: Hazards Identification

- **Classification (GHS):** Flammable Liquid (Category 3); Acute Toxicity Oral (Category 4); Skin Irritant (Category 2); Eye Irritant (Category 2A).
- **Signal Word:** Danger
- **Hazard Statements:**

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- Causes skin irritation
- Causes serious eye irritation

Section 3: Composition / Information on Ingredients

- **Concentration:** $\geq 99\%$
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Section 4: First Aid Measures

- **Inhalation:** Remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, seek medical attention immediately.
 - **Skin Contact:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.
 - **Eye Contact:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Seek medical advice immediately if irritation persists.
 - **Ingestion:** Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Seek immediate medical advice.
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Section 5: Fire-Fighting Measures

- **Suitable Extinguishing Media:** Dry chemical, foam, carbon dioxide (CO₂); water spray.
- **Specific Hazards:** Flammable liquid and vapor; vapors may form explosive mixtures with air; combustion may produce carbon oxides and irritating fumes.

- **Protective Equipment:** Firefighters should wear self-contained breathing apparatus and protective clothing.

Section 6: Accidental Release Measures

- **Personal Precautions:** Use personal protective equipment. Avoid breathing vapors. Ensure adequate ventilation. Eliminate ignition sources.
- **Environmental Precautions:** Prevent entry into drains and waterways.
- **Cleanup Methods:** Absorb with inert material (sand, earth). Collect in suitable container for disposal.

Section 7: Handling and Storage

- **Handling:** Avoid inhalation of vapors and contact with skin/eyes. Use with adequate ventilation. Keep away from ignition sources.
- **Storage:** Keep container tightly closed. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from heat and oxidizing agents.

Section 8: Exposure Controls / Personal Protection

- **Exposure Limits:** ACGIH TLV 50 ppm (TWA); OSHA PEL 50 ppm (TWA).
- **Engineering Controls:** Provide adequate ventilation and local exhaust if needed.

- **Personal Protective Equipment:** Chemical-resistant gloves, safety goggles, protective clothing. Respirator if ventilation is inadequate.

- **Appearance:** Colorless to pale viscous liquid
- **Odor:** Mild camphor-like odor
- **Boiling Point:** 161 °C
- **Flash Point:** 65 °C (closed cup)
- **Solubility:** Moderately soluble in water; miscible with alcohol and most organic solvents
- **Molecular Weight:** 100.16 g/mol

Section 10: Stability and Reactivity

- **Stability:** Stable under normal conditions.
- **Incompatible Materials:** Strong oxidizing agents.
- **Hazardous Decomposition Products:** Carbon oxides and irritating fumes under fire conditions.
